

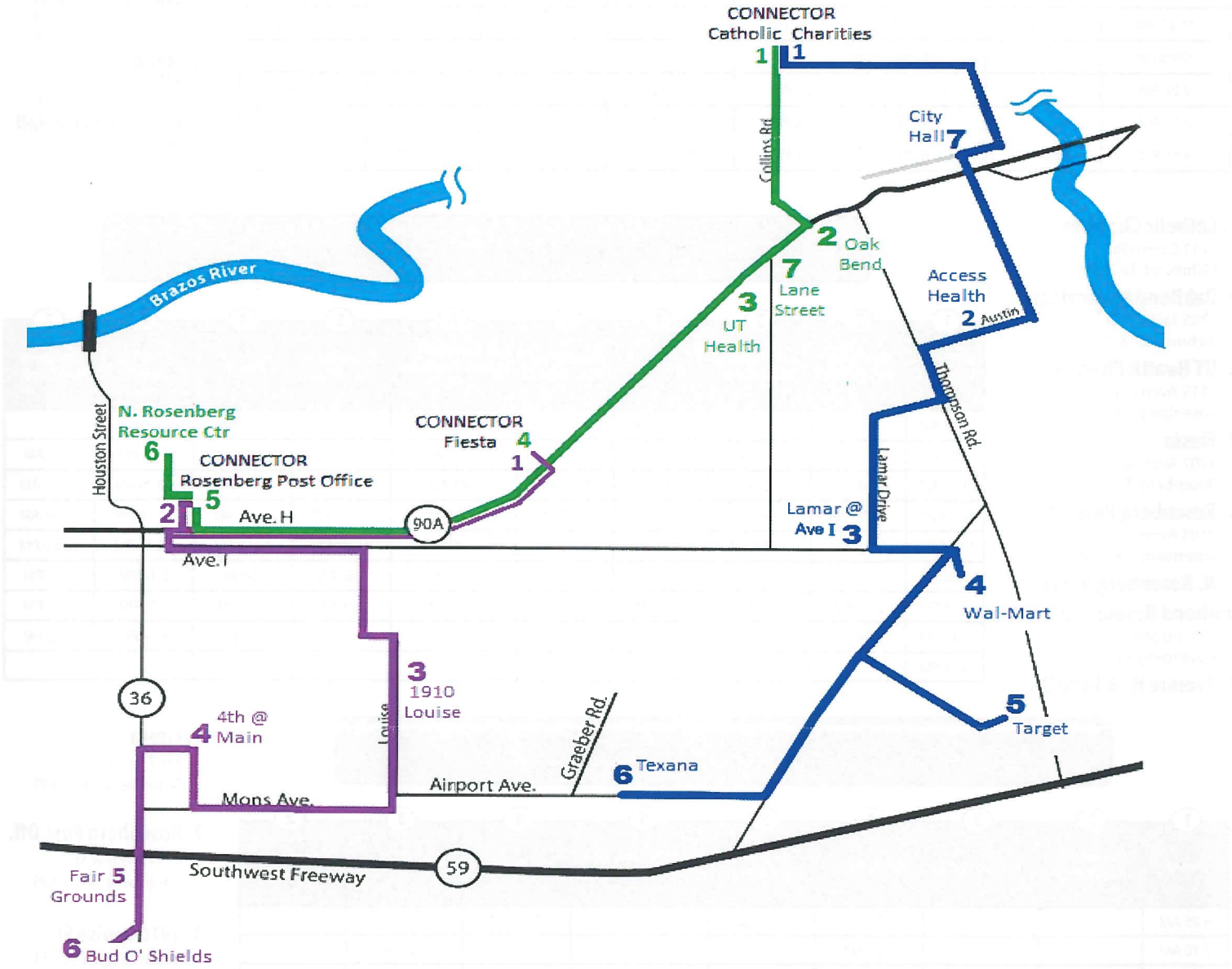
Richmond - Rosenberg Point Deviation Bus Service Map & Schedule
